



## JANUARY 21 FEATURED SERVICE PROJECT JOBS

**#1 SHEET RIP:** Each Dreamline Banner expressing an individual's dreams of a World Without Gun Violence needs a 9 x 24 in. piece of cloth.  
**JOB:** Score and rip flat sheets into 9 x 24 pieces of cloth.  
 EACH BOOTH needs 50. 100 Booths = 5,000!

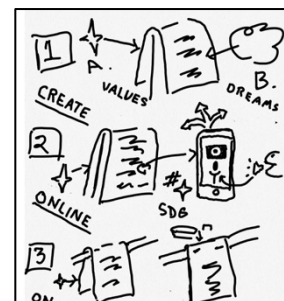
**#2 BOOTH BUILDING:** Each Dreamline Banner BOOTH is a portable immersive display of 50 Dreams of a World Without Gun Violence. They will move all across Philadelphia and beyond.

**JOB:** From pre-cut pieces of PVC pipe and joiners, build a Dream Booth using IKEA-like directions. Color code the pieces. Attach ribbons to display the World Without Gun Violence Dreamline Banners.



**#3 BANNER MAKING:** Our goal is to get as many of the 5,000 people attending the event to make a World Without Gun Violence Dreamline Banner as possible.

**JOB:** Use cloth, markers, and simple directions provided to express *your* personal values and your dreams of a world without gun violence. Help others make their own banners and attach them to display ribbons on a Dream Booth. *Techie Option:* Use your phone and the Dreamline App to upload and share Banners digitally.



**#4 MEMORIAL BOX CONSTRUCTION:** EACH Dream Booth will house a box commemorating an individual who died from gun violence in Philadelphia.

**JOB:** Help construct and sand a wooden hinged box from pre-cut parts.

**#5 BOOTH BREAKDOWN:** AFTER each Dream Booth is constructed, color coded, covered with Dreamline Banners, and fitted with a shelf and memorial box, it must be TAKEN APART and PACKED to go out into the city where it will be reassembled for display.

**JOB:** Deconstruct and pack Banners, Box, and Booth using bags, tape, and simple directions provided.
